




SAFETY WARNINGS AND CAUTIONS



(1) ATTACHING THE UPRIGHT SUPPORTS TO TRAYS AND SIDE HANDLE

- 1. Locate the bottom tray (11 with additional castor holes).
- 2. Ensure the 4 upright supports (2) are correct way up (see drawing) and place the hooked sections onto the bottom tray. Loosely attach them with the bolts (5) and nuts (9).
- 3. Fit the top tray (1) into the slots on the upright supports (loosen the lower bolts more if required).
- 4. The handle (3) can be placed into the lower or upper mounting holes either side of the trolley. Use the longer bolts (4) and nuts (9) to install the handle.
- 5. Fit the remaining nuts and bolts to the top tray and uprights, Square up the unit and tighten all securely.

(2) ATTACHING THE CASTORS

- 1. Lay the cart down on its back. Use the packaging material to protect the paint finish.
- 2. Mount both swivel castors with brake (6) on the same side of the cart as the handle.
- 3. Attach each castor using 4 bolts (7) and nuts (8) per castor.
- 4. Return the cart to its upright position.

MAINTENANCE

Castors should be lubricated periodically.(See Halford's lubricant range). Hardware (nuts, bolts, screws) should be tightened periodically to maintain trouble free operation.
