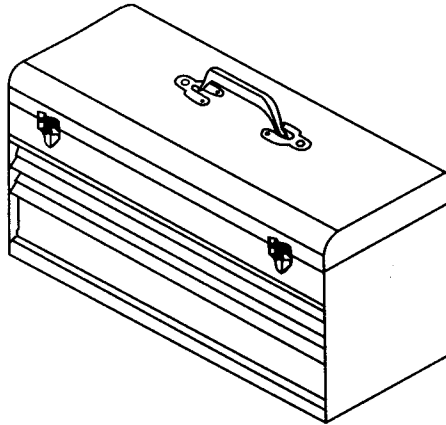

SAFETY WARNINGS AND CAUTIONS

To avoid personal injury or product damage:

- * **DO NOT** stand on this product.
- * **WEAR SAFETY GLASSES** when removing or repositioning the slides.
- * **When moving this product, do not pull it. Push the product.**
- * **Swivel castors must be attached to the same side of this product.**
- * **USE THE CASTOR LOCKS** when not moving this product. This will prevent the product from rolling.

- * **DO NOT** open more than one drawer at a time.
- * **DO NOT** mount this product on a truck bed or any other moving object.
- * **DO NOT** stand in the drawers.
- * **DO NOT** alter this product in any manner. For example, do not weld external lockbars or attach electrical equipment.

- * **Keep this product on level surfaces.** The product may become unstable and tip if stored or moved on an un-level surface.
- * **When loading the drawers, be careful not to put too many heavy items in the top drawer.** The product could become top heavy and tip.
- * **BE CAREFUL** when closing the cover. Remove hands before the cover closes completely.
- * **Close the cover and lock the drawers and door before moving this product.** The drawers or door could open and make this product unstable and tip.
- * **The maximum weight for each drawer should be no more than 9kgs.**
- * **The maximum product weight including contents, should be no more than 200kgs for the tool center.**

OPERATION

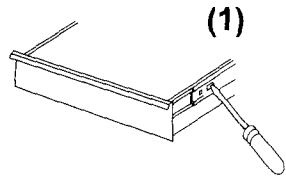
(1) REMOVING AND INSTALLING DRAWERS

A. Pull the drawer all the way open then push it back to align lance stop with the opening.

B. Push the lance stop in with screwdriver as shown until lance stop clears the stop on the drawer guide.

C. Repeat on other side and remove drawer.

To reinstall the drawer, pry out the lance stop (approx. 1/4") and slide drawer channels back into glides. firmly push drawer until it reaches the closed position.



(2) LOCKING

Close all drawers before locking, if a drawer is not locked, unlock unit and push drawer to the closed position before locking.

MAINTENANCE

Maintenance of Chest and Cabinet

Drawer slides and castors should be Lubricated Periodically. (See Halford's lubricant range). Hardware (Nuts, Bolts, Screws) should be tightened periodically to maintain trouble free operation.
