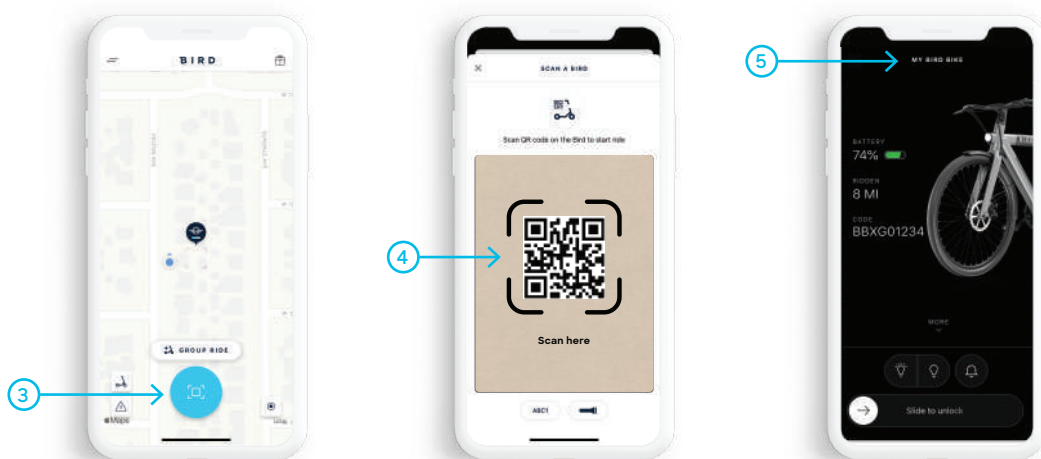

What you need to get started:

How to connect:

- 1 Power on Bird Bike by long pressing the Power Button on the handlebar.
- 2 Locate the unique QR code on the inside of the top lid of the Toolkit box.
- 3 Make sure Bluetooth is enabled on your device. Open the Bird app and tap on the scan button to open up the QR scanner.
- 4 Scan the Toolkit unique QR code and follow the pairing instructions within the Bird app.
- 5 Once complete, you will be able to view your bike's data within the Bird app from the **My Bird Bike** page.



Note: This process creates a secure, closed pairing with the bike for a single user. Once a closed pairing is activated, the bike will not be available for pairing by other nearby Bird app users. To allow pairing by another user, you must unpair from the bike first.
